In 1998, Lukehart developed the first version of LivingTime, a software program for recording and charting the events of a person's life. Available for both Windows and Macintosh, LivingTime is combination of diary, logbook, calendar, photo album, and graphical timeliner.

The program enables a person to collect and review the significant events that have happened in their life, or the life of a parent or child. In addition to composing an individual's life history, the program provides access to thousands of world events that can be imported to provide additional richness and perspective to the act of remembering one's experiences. Users create a personalized timeline, complete with journal entries, photographs and small videos.

Today, LivingTime is used by people of all ages and backgrounds as a way to document memorable moments and significant events.
